Agreements must be signed and submitted to UC San Diego during the spring of the senior year of high school or during the first year (after high school graduation) at the community college. International students are not eligible.
- **AGREEMENT:** After successful completion of the UniversityLink program, the student named above will be eligible for admission to UC San Diego.
- CONDITIONS: Apply to UC San Diego no later than four years from the time of submitting a signed UniversityLink Program Agreement. Guaranteed admission applies only to fall quarter enrollment. Admission to choice of UC San Diego undergraduate college and major are not guaranteed.
- **REQUIREMENTS:** The student named above must fulfill the following academic requirements by the end of the SPRING term, prior to FALL admission; completion of program requirements are highly recommended.

ACADEMIC (Required)

- Earn 60 UC-transferable semester units; achieve a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 in all UC-transferable courses by end of fall term prior to fall admission, and maintain the 3.0 GPA through end of spring term prior to fall admission; and meet UC subject eligibility 2 transferable courses in English composition, 1 transferable math course and 4 transferable college courses covering two of the following three areas: arts & humanities; social & behavioral science; physical & biological science.
- Complete 30 UC-transferable units, at least two regular semesters and the last term of enrollment prior to admission at a California community college.
- Submit an official UC Admission Application during the filing period and comply with all UC requirements and deadlines.

PROGRAM (Recommended)

- 1 individual appointment per semester with a community college counselor and at least 1 contact per year with the UC San Diego representative.
- Enroll in a College Success Skills course (if available) during first year at the community college.
- Attend UniversityLink program meetings every year at the community college.
- > Attend a UC application workshop.
- > Participate in a UC San Diego campus visit.
- > Participate in other activities as recommended.
