American Indian Biographies – Biographical sketches are supplemented by short article bibliographies; b&w photos and maps; lists of people by tribal affiliation, year of birth, and variant spellings; a time line; and a subject index. **REF. E 89 A46**

American Indians - 3 vols. – Tribes, languages, places, people, and more are covered in alphabetically arranged articles containing b&w photos or drawings, maps, and/or short bibliographies. Lists of educational institutions and programs; festivals and pow-wows; museums, archives, and libraries; organizations, agencies, and societies; reservations and bands are in vol. 3. A timeline, glossary, bibliography, and index complete the set. **REF. E76.2 A45**

Atlas of American Indian Affairs – “Presents in cartographic form essential historical and current data on American Indians and Alaska Natives.” Covers “culture areas and historical tribal locations; Indian land cessions; past and present reservations; governmental entities that have dealt with Indians (trading houses, Indian agencies, schools, and hospitals) at various times; removals to and Indian populations of Oklahoma (Indian Territory); and Alaska Native villages, corporations, and populations.” Also provides maps that “illustrate the westward-moving Indian frontier,” including “army posts, military engagements, reservations, and land cessions from the years of the early Republic to the late nineteenth century.” “Sites of major Indian uprisings and military engagements” are also depicted. **REF. G 1201 E1 P7**

Dictionary of Indians of North America – 3 vols. – Alphabetically arranged entries on important Indians from many different tribes are supplemented by b&w photos. **REF. E 89 D43**

Dictionary of Native American Mythology - Alphabetically arranged entries cover over 100 cultures, including names, phrases, symbols, images, motifs, themes, and more. B&w maps, drawings, and photos; cross-references; a bibliography; and an index by tribe complete the volume. **REF. E 98 R3 G46**

Dictionary of the American Indian - People, places, things, and terms relating to a variety of Indian tribes. **REF. E 77 S84**

Encyclopedia of American Indian Contributions to the World: 15,000 Years of Inventions and Innovations – Article bibliographies; b&w photos and maps; cross-references; appendices; a chronology; lists of entries by tribe or group, geographic culture area, and subject; and an index augment the alphabetically arranged articles. **REF. E 54.5 K46**

Encyclopedia of Native American Religions – Traditions, practices, sacred sites, court cases, important people, and more are covered in alphabetically arranged articles. B&w photos, a bibliography, and subject and general indexes complete the volume. **REF. E 98 R3 H73**

Native America in the Twentieth Century: An Encyclopedia - All aspects of Indian life are covered in alphabetically arranged articles supplemented by bibliographies, maps, photos, tables, and graphs. An index is at the back. **REF. E 76.2 N36**

Native North American Almanac: A Reference Work on Native North Americans in the United States and Canada – Sections covered include: chronology, populations, major culture areas, languages, law and legislation, environment, activism, religion, arts, literature, media, health, education, economy, and prominent people. Bibliographies, b&w photos, a glossary, and indexes complete the volume. **REF. E 77 N37**
