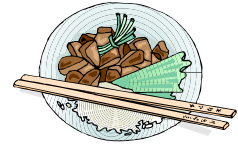

**Asian American Literature: An Annotated Bibliography** – Chinese, Japanese, Filipino, Korean, Vietnamese, and South Asian American literature are covered. Primary and secondary sources, prose, poetry, drama, periodicals, books, and more are included. A list of background sources and several indexes complete the volume. **REF. PS 153 A84 C47**

**Asian American Novelists: A Bio-Bibliographical Critical Sourcebook** – Alphabetically arranged articles cover each author's life, works, themes, and "critical reception." Bibliographies of materials by and about the novelist are at the end of each article. **Asian American Short Story Writers: An A-to-Z Guide** – Articles contain biographical information, major works and themes, "critical reception," and bibliographies of works by and about the author. A bibliography and index are at the end. **REF. PS 153 A84**
