

HOW TO USE THE MESA COLLEGE JOURNAL & NEWSPAPER LIST

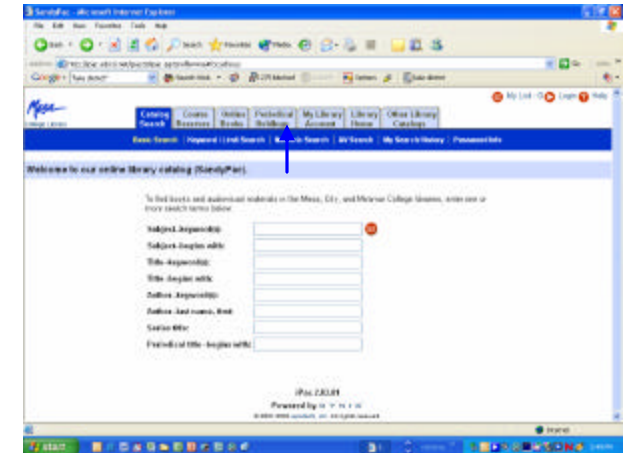
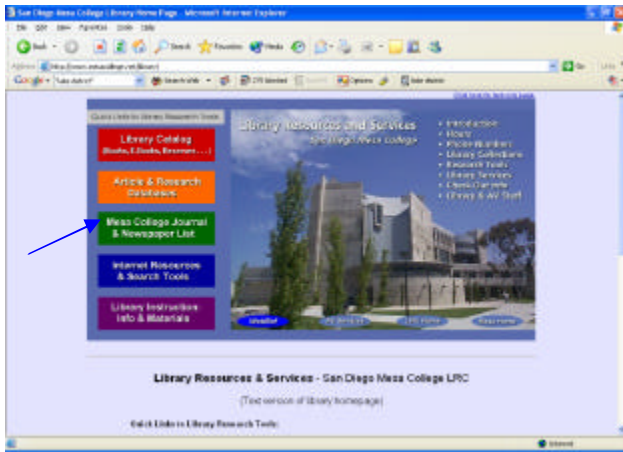
The Mesa College Journal & Newspaper List contains information as to every location within the Library where a full-text version of a magazine, journal, or newspaper, either electronic or non-electronic, can be found.

There are three ways to enter the list:

(1) Via the Library's home page

(2) Via a link from the Article & Research Databases page

(3) Via a tab in the Library's online catalog

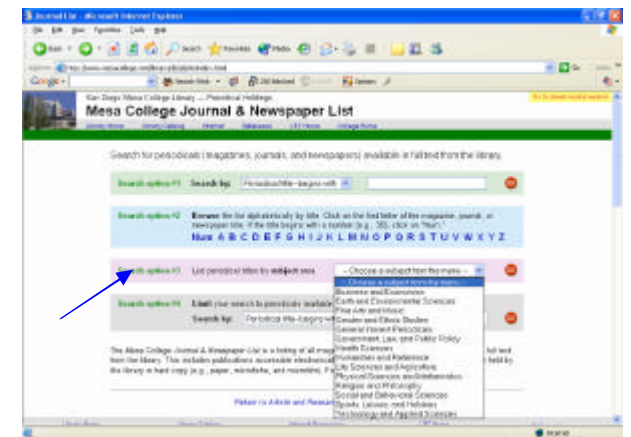
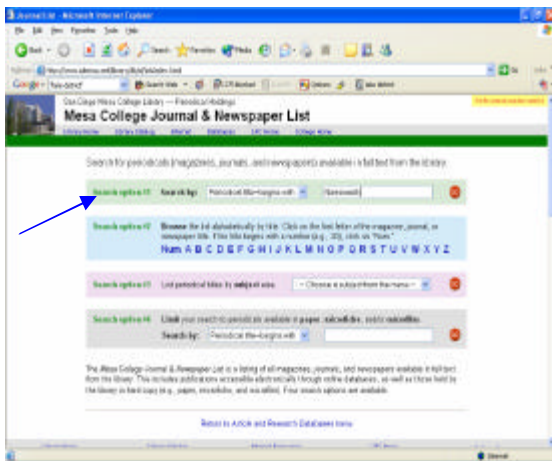


Whichever entrance you use, you can search for a magazine, journal, or newspaper in three ways:

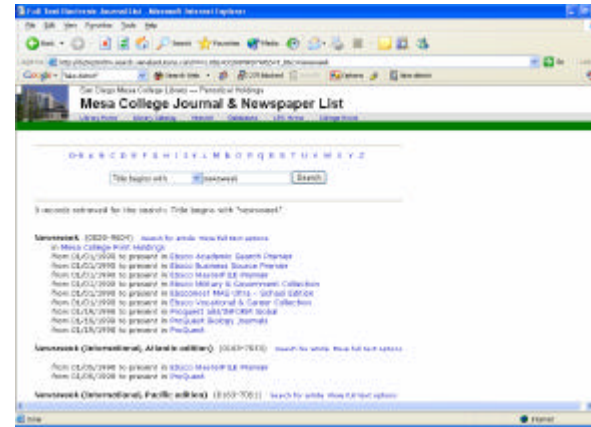
(1) Type in the name of the periodical

(2) Use the alphabetical list

(3) Check within a subject area



No matter what method you use, you want to get to here:

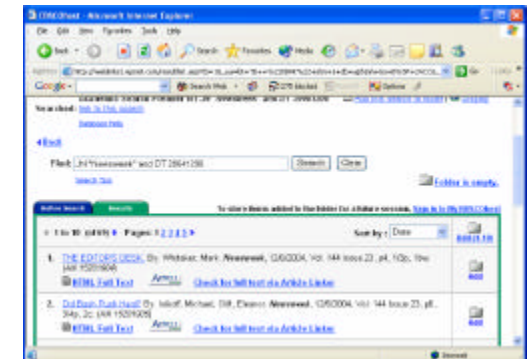
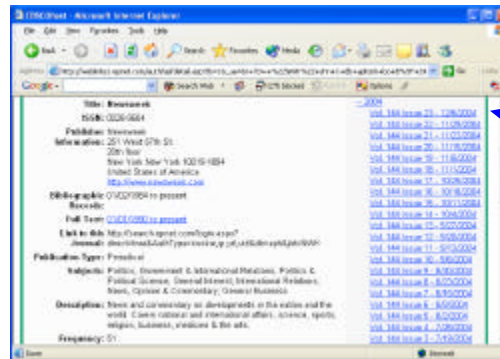
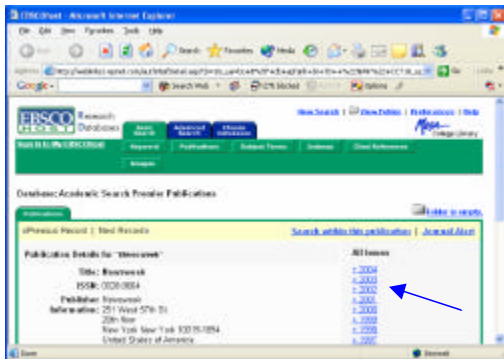


By clicking on one of the database links, you will be able to find the article online, as follows:

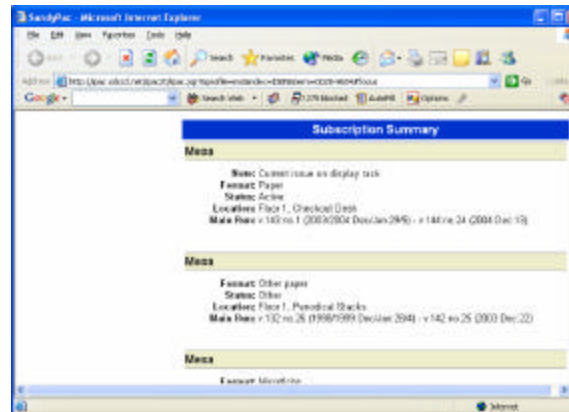
(1) Years available for a title
